The Australian Youth Championships bring together eight national age Club Championships; 12&U Boys and Girls, 14&U Boys and Girls, 16&U Boys and Girls and 18&U Men and Women. The **2019** event will be hosted in **Brisbane, Queensland** with more than 3000 young water polo players expected for a two-week festival of water polo and many more other activities.
